Credential Attainment Policy

The Workforce Investment Board (WIB) established the following as the policy for declaring credential attainment:

An industry, employer trade union, or association recognizes the credential as meeting the standards necessary to perform the duties required of the occupation. The credential certifies the customer has skills needed to obtain placement in a job, position, or occupation to which the instruction program is designed. The credentialed training program is in an industry that offers opportunities for growth and career advancement.

At a minimum, a customer seeking a credential should meet the following requirements:

1. Successfully complete a State of California recognized or accredited training program in an area that offers opportunities for growth and career advancement, and, as appropriate, pass an examination that determines competency.²

OR

2. Successfully complete an industry, business, union, or association recognized training program in an area that offers opportunities for growth and career development.³

² The State of California approved all course offerings on the ETPL. Passing of an examination is only appropriate where a license or certificate is required to practice.

³ On-the-job training may be considered industry-recognized if the employer certifies it as such.
